HOW TO SUBMIT

Work with all 6 branches of the K-family to hold a Thanksgiving dinner for your community members, specifically for those in need. Focus on homeless shelters or senior centers and work collaboratively to hold a dinner for them, by reaching out to local venues, food banks, and possible volunteers to help prepare and serve the food. Make it a team effort!

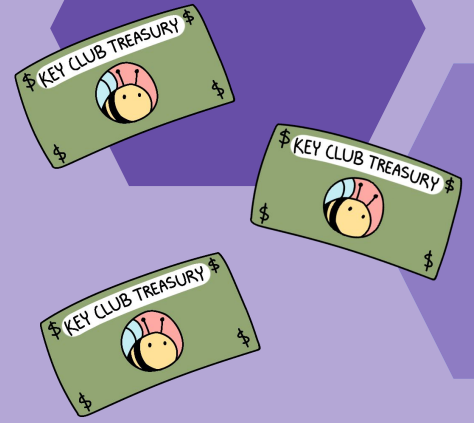
K-Fam FUN

Work with your K-Fam Ohana to host monthly or bi-monthly events for all 6 branches and community members. This can be as casual as a bingo family or movie night, and it allows for the opportunity to bond with the different branches of Kiwanis. Different activities such as letter making for Kiwanians can take place for members to participate in.

Key Club Takeover

Plan a day for your Key Club division to “take over” your sponsoring Kiwanis Club at their Division Council Meeting or event. This is the perfect opportunity to update your local Kiwanians on your division’s work throughout the term, and on future events too. Continue to bond with your Kiwanians at the takeover by also holding an ice cream social, taco party, etc.

Hold a Bake Sale with the Kiwanis

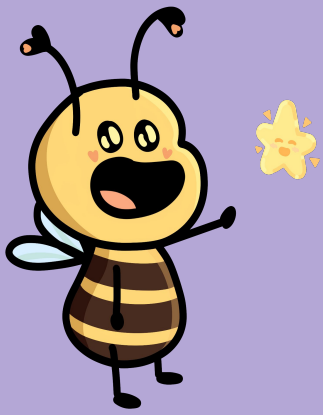
Find out when your Kiwanis club hosts their meetings. Then, communicate with them to find a day for your Key Clubbers to attend a meeting and host a bake sale. You can use the money from the Kiwanians for your club, PTP donations, or however you see fit. It is also a great way to meet your fellow Kiwanians!

Host a Day of K-Fam Fun

Work with any branch(es) of the Kiwanis family to host a Day of Fun! Work together to host activities for your community or a school of choice. Have people pay an entrance fee or for food and activities to raise funds for whatever organizations you guys would like to donate to.

Make and Sell Crafts

This idea is especially good to do with K-Kids or Builder's Clubs. If a school event is coming up, you can work with them in the weeks leading up to it to create things that can be sold for a good cause. It is also a great way to bond with them and you can learn more about each other's organizations.

Improve Schools with Builder's Clubs or K-Kids

Do you have a Builder's Club or K-Kids in your community? Work with them to have a project that will have a lasting impact on their schools! This can be something from starting a garden, painting a mural, fixing their playgrounds, or whatever your organizations see as fit.

Have a Key Club Education Day

If you have any Builder's Clubs in your area, go to one of their meetings and educate them about Key Club. This will show them that their Kiwanis Family journey can continue in high school and it can further motivate them to join Key Club. Key Clubbers can answer any questions the middle schoolers may have and they can tell them about their time in Key Club.

Make Care Packages

Work together with the Kiwanis Family branch(es) of your choice to make care packages and donate them to a group in your town that you think needs it. Work together to gather the items and supplies needed. Then, set a day aside to work together to put the packages together.
